Saturday Evening Jeffrey Adams CCI Wounded Veterans Initiative Speaker

On November 7, 2004 First Lieutenant Jeffrey Adams lost his leg to a roadside bomb while stationed in Iraq. Serving with the Louisiana National Guard, Adams was on patrol checking debris on the road when an insurgent with a cell phone detonated a roadside bomb just 10 feet away from him. He looked down and his entire left leg was gone. On February 14, 2008 Adams' life became a little bit easier when he received an assistance dog, Sharif, from the Southeast Region of Canine Companions for Independence through their Wounded Veterans Initiative. Adams is a resident of Huntsville, Alabama and is employed by the Boeing Corporation.
